Root Causes is an interdisciplinary incubator for students to understand and build innovative social drivers of health (SDOH) interventions through service, advocacy, education, and research. They provide opportunities for undergraduate and professional learners to develop an appreciation for how these social drivers of health show up in healthcare, engage with or build community partnership programs that address them, and leave feeling empowered to become leaders in the future to address issues of SDOH. They run community-based programs such as the Fresh Produce Program that supports over 350 community members with food insecurity, the WellNest Housing Support Program that assists over 20 newly-housed community members with building a home, Healthy Harvest that runs a local community garden, and Exercise as Medicine that supports community members in reaching their exercise goals. Nonprofit Farmer Foodshare works closely with Root Causes' Fresh Produce Program to distribute fresh produce to the local community!

Directors' Note

The Broadway musical *Legally Blonde* is notoriously challenging. It requires an almost frightening level of energy to perform vocally, physically, and emotionally — as a production team we knew we were presenting the ultimate challenge to our cast, but we hoped that at the end of the day, it would be an unforgettably FUN experience.

This cast has far exceeded our expectations, coming into rehearsals with all the energy and enthusiasm this show requires, and then some...all while studying their butts off to nail their medical school exams! (What, like it's hard?)

It is indisputable that the world has changed tremendously since the film “Legally Blonde” first premiered in 2001. Yet, Elle Woods still remains a pop culture icon 21 years later, thanks to her resilience and unapologetically positive personality - and, dare we say, great sense of style! In the original text, Elle struggles to find her way in a similarly elite academic institution, navigating law school, discovering her passions, and developing her voice, while seeking to gain the respect of her peers and professors. She weathers nearly unrelenting efforts to undermine her capabilities, reflecting the very real challenges that many individuals - especially women - face in the professional realm. As a creative team, we did not want to shy away from these uncomfortable topics: instead, we sought to give voice to our shared experiences as medical students, and to depict how change can happen when we advocate for ourselves and each other.

Elle's experience does not represent that of all women or all people, but, importantly, she is not alone on her journey. The characters you will meet throughout the production are modeled after the struggles, achievements, flaws, and desires that we and our classmates face. There are moments when these characters are carried away by competition, judgment, preconceived notions, and invulnerability; other times, we share in their excitement and pride that comes with gaining medical knowledge and skills. Ultimately, our characters learn that working together, valuing others' talents, quirks, and interests, and staying unified in the ultimate goal of patient-centered care can lead to pretty incredible things!

This show is part of a legacy over 80 years in the making, as the Student Faculty Show is one of the longest held traditions at Duke SOM. Since the 1940s, students and faculty have joined together yearly to poke fun at the unique idiosyncrasies of the Duke medical student experience, sharing stories and building community through song and dance. We are honored to uphold this tradition, and we hope you enjoy this reimagined classic with a medical twist.



Yeah. And it's so me.


That's the best part. Specialty's new.

ADH: antidiuretic hormone, often a cause of low sodium

ANA: a test of autoimmune disease

Anki: a popular online flashcard program used by medical students

Aortic, pulmonic, tricuspid, mitral, and Erb's point: locations and sounds to check when listening to the heart

Bactrim: a common antibiotic

Blood in the bowel: symptoms of bleeding somewhere in the GI tract

Boards and Beyond: a popular test-prep resource

BRBPR: abbreviation for bright red blood per rectum

BUN: blood urea nitrogen

Clinical Skills Intensive: the one-month "bootcamp" prior to beginning clinical rotations in MS2 at Duke

Conversion disorder: neurologic symptoms that can't be explained by medical evaluation, a diagnosis of exclusion

Craniotomy: operations involving a hole in the skull

Creatinine: a measure of kidney function

Currant jelly stool: a hallmark symptom of intussusception, translucent red blood in the stool

Differential: possible disorders that could be behind a set of symptoms

Diplopia: double vision

DiSC: a leadership style assessment with categories of Dominance, Influence, Steadiness, and Conscientiousness

Dr. Robbins: author of a prominent pathology textbook

ERAS: Electronic Residency Application Service, the residency application portal

ESR, CRP: nonspecific lab tests for inflammation

First Aid: a well-known test-prep resource, particularly for Step 1

Guillain-Barre: a neurological condition with ascending numbness in the limbs

Gunning: highly competitive attitude towards school, often at the expense of others

HAFS: Hospital Addition for Surgery

IBD: inflammatory bowel disease

Intussusception: when one part of the bowel slides into the next, like a telescope, causing blockage, swelling, and bleeding

IV pentamidine: a different antibiotic that can affect the kidneys

Liver mets: short for liver metastases, spread of cancer to the liver

Meckel's diverticulum: a small pouch in the wall of the intestine, present from birth

Meconium: baby's first poop!

Med Ed, UWorld, Amboss: popular test-prep resources for medical students

MMI: Multiple Mini Interview, the format conducted by Duke

MSTP: Medical Scientist Training Program, students who are pursuing dual MD and PhD degrees

Nature: a major research journal

Ophtho: short for Ophthalmology

Oxidant-induced hemolytic reaction: a devastating reaction involving the destruction of blood cells

P=MD: the refrain of students saying that passing = graduating medical school

Palpate the liver: a notoriously difficult physical exam maneuver

Patagonia: the brand of jackets often worn by medical students (often in gray or navy colors)

Perfed the bowel: accidentally putting a hole in the intestines, a complication of abdominal surgery

Pimped: word on the street is that it's short for "put in my place," i.e., being asked difficult questions while in clinic or on the wards (often in public)

Post-call: the day after a long (usually 12 or 24-hour) shift

PSC: primary sclerosing cholangitis, a disease of the bile ducts

Rosalind: reference to Rosalind Franklin, British Chemist whose work crucially contributed to the discovery of the DNA double helix

Scope: a camera sent into the GI tract

Shelf: standardized exams following each clerkship rotation

Shooters: the local dance saloon in Downtown Durham

Sketchy Micro: a popular test-prep resource using fun cartoons

SOAP: a medical note in the format of Subjective, Objective, Assessment, and Plan

STEMI: a type of heart attack

Step 1: the first medical board exam, often a large source of stress for students

Step 2: the second medical board exam

Sub-I: Sub-internship, an immersive clinical rotation for graduating students

Tachycardic: fast heartbeat

Tenaculum: a clamp tool used often in Gynecology

USMLE: United States Medical Licensing Exam

Watson: reference to one-half of the scientist duo credited with the discovery of DNA structure
